



Fees Payments Policy

The Ipswich City Football Club needs your fees to operate and remain financially viable. Your fees are the major source of income for our club. Your fees enable the committee to provide you with the playing and training facilities, playing and training equipment, affiliation fees, referee fees, insurances, trophies and all the other extras that go towards making our club the friendly and family orientated place that it is.

We recognise that for some families the requirement to pay full fees at one time can cause impacts on the family budget. We have therefore developed the following payment options;

- We strongly encourage full payment at sign on. The club will accept payment via; cash, cheque, Eftpos and credit cards
 - If full payment at sign on can't be achieved we will enter into a Direct Debit arrangement as defined in the 2012 Fees schedule
- ❖ **Please note these very important points**, the registration process will not be completed until full payment is received or a Direct Debit agreement is completed. Also all fees and charges incurred by the club will be passed on to the parent or player.
 - ❖ In the case of junior players, they will not be allocated to a team until full payment is received so therefore they may not be in the same team as friends or family
 - ❖ If full payment is not received by the agreed timeframes, the player will be unable to train or participate in any club activities.
