



Registration Options for 2012

The Football Federation of Australia (FFA) has once again rolled out its Online Registration web site. The FFA MyFootballClub web site allows existing players to re-register and new players to complete all the required registration processes on line from the comfort of their own home.

As a club we would strongly encourage parents and players to take advantage of this web site and register on line. After completing the online registration process the only thing left to do is pay your fees. The system will generate an invoice for you and you can bring that down to the club. It would be appreciated if payment could be completed on the designated sign on days.

If you decide not participate in the online registration process, you are welcome to come down to the club during the designated sign on days and provide the required information.

We recognise that for some families the requirement to pay full fees at one time can cause impacts on the family budget. This year the committee has decided to offer two payment options to members;

1. Pay full fees in one payment, either by cash, cheque or Eftpos
2. Enter into a Direct Debit process as defined in the 2012 fees document. The Direct Debit form is available on our website. You will have to provide bank account details etc to complete this form, so it may be more efficient to download the form and complete it before coming to the club.

- ❖ **Please note these very important points**, the registration process will not be completed until full payment is received or a Direct Debit agreement is completed,
- ❖ All fees and charges incurred by the club will be passed on to the parent or player.
- ❖ In the case of junior players, they will not be allocated to a team until full payment is received so therefore they may not be in the same team as friends or family
- ❖ If full payment is not received by the agreed timeframes, the player will be unable to train or participate in any club activities.
